

## Board Director

■ Mr. Camp is a Managing General Partner and co-founder of CampVentures, a seed-stage venture capital firm based in Silicon Valley. During his tenure with the firm, he has made 37 investments in 22 seed- and early-stage companies, and has backed such companies as BlueSteel Networks, Cepheid, Quorum Systems, Clarus Systems, and Mirra. Prior to CampVentures, Mr. Camp was a corporate attorney with the Wall Street law firm of Cravath Swaine & Moore, focusing on securities offerings and mergers & acquisitions transactions.

■ Mr. Camp also authored *Venture Capital Due Diligence* (John Wiley & Sons, 2002), a book which was included in the prestigious Wiley Finance Series. *Venture Capital Due Diligence* is used by many of the top graduate business programs, including the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania, the Tuck School of Business at Dartmouth, the Mendoza College of Business at Notre Dame, the Whitman School of Management at Syracuse University, and the School of Business at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. It is also used in business programs internationally, such as INSEAD in Paris; the Graduate School of Business of the Université de Lausanne, Switzerland; Heinrich-Heine Universität Düsseldorf, Germany; Warsaw University, Poland; and the Graduate School of International Management at Chung-Ang University in Seoul, Korea.

■ Mr. Camp is on the Board of Directors of TXE Systems and Picaboo, and participates on the boards of Clarus Systems, WiDeFi, Quorum Systems, MetroFi, and Larian Communications as a board observer. He also served on the executive board of the West Coast Chapter of the Wharton Private Equity Network from 2002 to 2004 and is a Venture Capital Partner of the Entrepreneurs Foundation, a nonprofit created to strengthen the San Francisco Bay Area community by creating a culture of community involvement and philanthropy within entrepreneurial companies.

■ In addition to a J.D. degree (with honors) from the University of Pennsylvania Law School, Mr. Camp graduated with honors with a BA degree from UCLA in Economics and Political Science.
